FEE SCHEDULE – COPYING PHONOGRAMS TO BE A PART OF A VISUAL RECORDING (TELEVISION)

Gramex grants licenses for copying recorded music to TV programs, documentaries and short films. The license gives the right to use such programs on TV, the web service of broadcasting companies and in certain SVOD services, as well as to screen documentaries and short films at film festivals.
